4. Provision of ideas and strategies to support the implementation of learning activities that address the expectations in the oral language strand of the
5. Language curriculum in infants.
6. Looking at assessment strategies and tools for literacy - discussion of assessment, including its role in literacy instruction and the various methods and tools for gathering, recording, interpreting, and communicating assessment information.

Additionally, teachers will discretely & systematically engage with the School Self-Evaluation processes & instruments with a view to later formulating and implementing a self improvement plan.

## Modules
